

GATE Portal Programme

The Portal programme takes place in Year 11 and its purpose is to maximise GATE students' performance and ensure they meet or exceed their GCSE targets. The process comprises the following:

September – March of Year 11

- Sharing and analysing progress data to set both subject specific or more generic goals (e.g. personal organisation)
- Group and individual mentoring and coaching by the gate Co-ordinator to set and achieve both short and long-term goals
- Individual GATE report where appropriate to support progress in specific subjects
- Liaison with parents as appropriate

March – April Year 11

- Time management and prioritisation
- Techniques for coping with stress
- A range of revision and study skills techniques
- Subject specific revision guidance from key staff
- External speaker/s
- Individual and group/revision approaches
